

Fukushima Revitalization Information Portal Site

This website is an official portal site of Fukushima Prefecture to present the current status of Fukushima's revitalization. The translated version, available in 10 languages, was renewed in October 2023. Please feel free to take a look.

Over the course of more than a decade since the Great East Japan Earthquake, the portal site has grown considerably in terms of information and content diversity. With the aim of providing information that is 'easy to read,' 'easy to understand' and 'up to date', the Prefecture undertook a thorough review of the site's organisation and layout, resulting in the renewal of the Japanese-language website in February 2023.

Consequently, the translated versions of the site have recently been revised to ensure that the current progress of Fukushima's revitalization can be disseminated to a wide international audience, including those with a keen interest in or support for the prefecture.

These versions share information divided into five major categories that cover initiatives undertaken from the time of the disaster to the present, including the damage caused by the Great East Japan Earthquake and the challenges taken up in new industries.

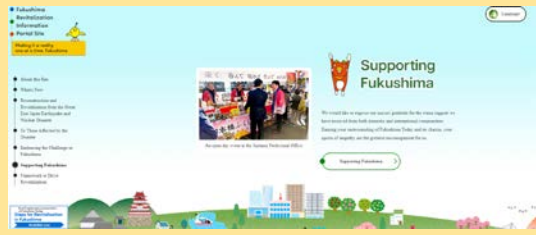
